


ECA's Role is Complex and Multifaceted





With a Unique Position in the National Economy


- ☐ It is part of the government's overall set of policy tools to promote trade and investment
- □ It focuses on large, medium and small companies
- ☐ It has unique knowledge of foreign markets and risks
- ☐ It is part of an international network, such as the Aman Union, Berne Union, ICISA





An ECA's Relationship with Government can be complex

- ☐ The Government plays a variety of roles vis-à-vis the ECA:
 - as guardian authority providing mandate and approval of annual strategic plan
 - as owner requiring financial sustainability and development impact
 - as funder providing capital and as ultimate backstop for losses
 - as reinsurer or refinancierproviding access to risk capacity




The Government's financial backing can take a variety of forms

- Capitalize agency and leave it to them to manage (Finland)
- Capitalize agency and put 90% of risks covered by Government Budget (Japan)
- 3. Put all risks on the Government Budget (Germany)
- Put all risks on the Government Budget but establish a maximum annual amount of expected losses allowed (United States)



ECAs intervene at many levels

- ☐ **Insurers** provide reinsurance and coinsurance
 - Also can help cash/treasury management
- ☐ **Financiers** Provide insurance
- □ Project Provide direct guarantee or risk sharing instrument on loan





- ☐ The ECA has a fine line between risk and opportunities
- ☐ Risk management is critical, not only for its own balance sheet, but also for clients with whom risks are shared.
- ☐ ECAs are critical public policy instruments for promoting trade and investment opportunities....
-but they are also critical public policy instruments for avoiding loss
